Seventeen high-interest theme sets each contain **four topic books**, each written at a different level to cater for individual reading needs.

While the different topic books address the developmental needs of students with varying reading abilities, they simultaneously allow for whole-group discussions and activities as the key concepts and core vocabulary remain the same.

Changes between theme books that cater for varying reading abilities

- each book explores a different topic that illustrates the central theme
- text increases and sentence structure becomes more complex
- vocabulary ranges from simple to complex
- number of concepts covered in a given section increases.

Similarities between theme books

- key concepts developed are the same
- a variety of visual-literacy elements are provided
- students are encouraged to research and write
- a variety of nonfiction characteristics are introduced.



Additional literacy features

Each theme set focuses on one nonfiction **genre**. Each book in the theme then defines and explains the text type and identifies its characteristics.

The books also provide explicit instruction on one **visual-literacy skill** and include activities designed to develop and refine **research and writing skills**.
